ATTENDANCE TO THE 3-DAY INTERNATIONAL TRAINING / WORKSHOP ON VALUES FORMATION AND PROFESSIONAL ETHICS FOR DEPED PERSONNEL

- In favor to the Regional Memorandum No. 260, s. 2023 titled 3-Day International Training/Workshop on Values Formation and Professional Ethics for DepEd Personnel, supporting the implementation of the MATATAG Agenda and DepEd Order No. 42, s. 2017 titled National Adoption of the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers, the Implementation of the Region 02's Basic Education Learning Continuity and Recovery Plan through the Cagayan Valley Association of Schools Superintendent (CVASS) in partnership with the Philippine Professional Linkages from Various Disciplines Inc. (PPLVDI), the DepEd Regional Office 02 shall be conducting the 3-day international training on September 21-23, 2023 to be held at the FLD Coliseum, Cauayan City.
- The abovementioned international training/workshop aims to capacitate leaders, teaching, and non-teaching personnel with the new trends to address the demands brought by the pandemic through enhancement of ethical discernment, to intensify their awareness of the clear demarcation between professional and personal ethics. This requires participants to bolster their comprehension regarding the distinct responsibilities of instructional leaders, as well as teaching and non-teaching staff, in the cultivation of critical thinking skills pertaining to ethical values when confronted with moral dilemmas. Additionally, investing in upskilling efforts aimed at embracing a New Mindset concerning their role in upholding professional ethics and adhering to a code of ethics, with the goal of seamlessly integrating these principles into their everyday encounters and workstations.
- Based on this, all education program supervisors, school heads, teaching, and non-teaching personnel are encouraged to attend and participate in the training/workshop, supporting leaders, teachers, and staff to be better. Each participant will gain 10 CPD units.
- A registration fee amounting to Php 4,500.00 will be collected from each participant to cover the expenses for the conduct of the training and to support the
