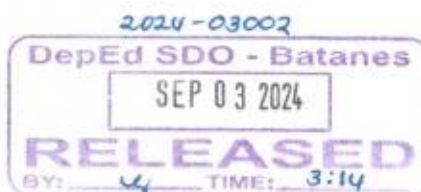

MOVES FOR THE OCEAN

An Online Dance and Music Contest for Cleaner and Waste-Free Oceans

I. Mechanics

1. Only youth participants aged 13-30 years old are eligible to join the competition. Submissions must be made as a group with 5-10 members.
2. Participants must use the song "Kung Walang Aksaya, Masaya" produced by DENR. The video entry should be 50% dance and 50% portrayal of good environmental practices, particularly focusing on waste management, cleanup drive initiatives, and other eco-friendly actions. (For the portrayal of good practices, community participation, all ages, is welcome.)
3. Dance routines must be performed by the with any waterbody (ocean, river, lake, etc) as the background. The environment should be a realistic setting and avoid using mobile filters.
4. Participants are encouraged to incorporate dance steps, styles, or choreography that align with the celebration.
5. Avoid wearing revealing costumes/outfits.
6. Entries should be recorded in high resolution, using a professional camera or mobile phone in landscape orientation.
7. Contestants must adhere to safety protocols and community guidelines while filming their videos.
8. All entries will be uploaded to the DENR Cagayan Valley Facebook Page for public voting. The entry with the highest number of reactions and shares will receive the special award. Cheating (auto-like, auto-share, auto-boost, etc.) of any form during online voting is prohibited.

II. Eligibility

The competition is open to youth participants in Region 2. DENR employees and their immediate family members are not allowed to join the contest.

III. Contest Period

Entries will be accepted via email until September 20, 2024 at 5:00 PM. Entries submitted beyond the deadline will not be accepted.

IV. Submission of Video Entries

1. Submit official entries at rscig.r2@denr.gov.ph
2. Deadline is on September 20, 2024 until 5:00 PM only.
3. File name of the entry must be in the format "GroupName_ICCU2024".



4. Contestants will be required to provide the following information upon submission of entries:

For the Group Leader:

- Full Name
- Date of Birth
- Email Address

- Mobile Number
- Complete Address
- Date and location where the video was taken (barangay, town, province)
- List of names of other members with date of birth

V. Contest Prizes

The winners shall receive the following:

<i>First Place</i>	-	<i>P10,000.00</i>
<i>Second Place</i>	-	<i>P7,000.00</i>
<i>Third Place</i>	-	<i>P5,000.00</i>
<i>People's Choice</i>	-	<i>P2,000.00</i>

The cash prizes and remittance fee, if needed, shall be charged to the office funds.

VI. Criteria for Judging

Relevance (Environmental Message)	-	35 %
Performance and Energy	-	35 %
Creativity and Video Quality	-	20 %
Online Engagement	-	10 %

VII. Notification and Awarding

Winners will be announced on September 24, 2024 via DENR Cagayan Valley Facebook Page. They shall also be notified via email and their contact number. The awarding ceremonies will be held on September 27, 2024 in Tuguegarao City during the culminating activity of the Civil Service Anniversary celebration.

Winners will be required to submit a copy of their valid ID and the proof of receipt of the cash prize.

By joining the contest, it is understood that the DENR Region 2 has the right to publish, and use in any media the contest's official entries for information, education and communication purposes.
