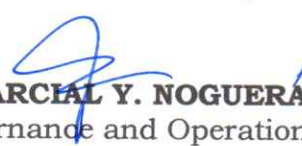

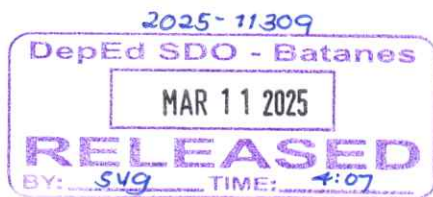

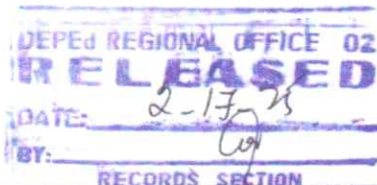

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**GENERAL GUIDELINES ON THE CONDUCT OF THE
2025 REGIONAL FESTIVAL OF TALENTS**

1. The participants of the **2025 Regional Festival of Talents** will showcase their best products and performances in the different events as evidence of their learning in the different learning areas based on the Revised K to 12 Curriculum.
2. The 2025 RFOT with the theme, *Galing, Talino, at Husay ng mga Batang Makabansa sa Diwa ng MATATAG na Adhika* shall be held in SDO Nueva Vizcaya from April 2-4, 2025.
3. The **2025 RFOT** shall showcase talents and skills of learners of the following areas/events:
 - 3.1. TECHNOLYMPICS;
 - 3.2. SINING TANGHALAN;
 - 3.3. READ-A-THON (ENGLISH & FILIPINO);
 - 3.4. LINGO STARS;
 - 3.5. HISTOPOP;
 - 3.6. MUSABAQAH;
 - 3.7. AGHAMAZING
 - 3.8. SPECIAL NEEDS EDUCATION (SNED) ABILYMPICS; and
 - 3.9. NUMBERACE.
4. All events of the 2025 RFOT shall be conducted under the competition category.
5. Participation is open to any learner who is currently enrolled in public or private elementary, secondary schools (Junior and /Senior High Schools) and other inclusion programs such as Alternative Learning System (ALS), Indigenous Peoples Education (IPed), Special Needs Education (SNEd), and Madrasah Education Program (MEP) for SY 2024-2025.
6. Learner-participants shall secure their parent/guardian's consent for participation in the 2025 RFOT and they shall be accompanied by their respective teacher-coaches.
7. A learner is allowed to participate in one (1) skill exhibition during the RFOT.
8. The details or specific requirements/guidelines and mechanics for participation are articulated in the guidelines of each event.

9. Only one (1) entry per event per division shall be accepted at the regional level duly endorsed by Schools Division Superintendent, to wit:

10. Strict observance of NO Disruption of Academic Classes and the implementation of Academic EASE must be always observed.

11. All Division Focal Persons of the different event/category are required to monitor and supervise the readiness of their participation during the contest proper.

12. The Regional Level Awards:

- 12.1. All entries shall be ranked from highest to lowest. However, only the top 5 entries shall be given corresponding points in determining the overall champion.
- 12.2. Only the top 5 winners of each event in the different skills exhibitions shall be declared.
- 12.3. The top 5 winners per event shall receive a certificate of recognition and medal.
- 12.4. The teacher-coach-trainer/adviser of the top 5 shall receive a certificate of recognition.
- 12.5. All Performers shall receive certificates of recognition as Regional Finalist.

13. The Point System will be used to determine the Over-All Champion during the RFOT.

13.1. The distribution of points are as follows:

14. Mechanics for Judging the Skills Exhibition:

14.1 The products and performances of participants in all events shall be judged by at least three (3) members of the board of judges composed of experts and practitioners.

14.2. The rank of the three or five judges in any event shall be computed

to determine the score of each participants/team. The average score shall be the basis for ranking the products/performances of participants to determine the top 5 winners.

14.3. The tabulation, Consolidation, and review of all results shall be done by a committee composed of two from the management staff, chair of the board of judges, and one representative from the host division.

14.4. the final results be reviewed by the members of the board of judges before they affix their signature on the summary sheet.

14.5. In the event of tie, the chair of the board of judges will decide and their decision is final and irrevocable.

15. The timelines for the conduct of the Festival of Talents shall be as follows:

15.1. School/District/Area/Congressional	February, 2025
15.2. Division Level	February-March, 2025
15.3. Regional Level	
Submission of List of Entries	March 26, 2025
Conduct of the RFOT	April 2-4, 2025
